

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Players Late to the Tee - Rule 6-3a

- Late to the Tee shall be deemed to be anyone who is not ready to hit off at their scheduled tee time.
- All players must register in the pro shop at least 15 minutes before scheduled tee time.

If a player is not present at the designated tee time and the fairway is clear the remaining players MUST hit off, unless the stand-by group is ready and agrees to move up. If all players present have teed off and departed the tee, the late player must join the group without teeing off from the first tee. In an individual stroke event the said player will be disqualified and may only play socially and act as a marker. In a four-ball or teams event the late arrival may only commence play from the next full hole the group will play.

Competition Time Sheets

Pacific Golf Club operates an electronic booking system. All time sheets open 8 days prior to the event day. Members have the option of either booking on the kiosk in the clubhouse or via the Members Portal on the website and Pacific Golf Club app.

Saturday Time Sheet

Timesheets are released 8 days prior to the event (Friday). The ballot sheet will be available from 5.30pm in the members bar with the ballot commencing at 6.15pm. Members will then be called in order from this ballot to enter their name into the timesheet at the kiosks. The remaining split of the time sheet will open on the Club Website at 7.30pm.

- Members are entitled to enter a maximum of 4 names into the kiosk at the time their names are called at the ballot
- Members must be there in person to enter their group in the kiosk and cannot use a proxy.

Prizes & Trophies

- Competition trophies are held at the Golf Office for a maximum period of 6 months.
- NTP's, approach and pro pin prizes are posted to the members/visitors prize account at the end of the competition day.

Scorecards

- Players are recommended to download and use the "Mi Score" app from the app store to score all competition rounds – please see pro shop for any questions.
- Manual scorecards must be completed, signed, entered and confirmed through the auto score scanning system and then returned to the scorecard box as soon as possible in accordance with Rule 6-6b.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Handicapping

- Players will use the daily handicap on the day given by Golf Australia.
- All competition scorecards entered are eligible for submission to Golf Link at completion of the round.
- Social score cards are not accepted for GA handicap alterations.

Behaviour & Etiquette

No Member or Visitor shall behave in a manner prejudicial to the welfare to the Club or its members and visitors.

Alcohol consumption on the premises

All alcoholic drinks consumed on the golf course MUST have been purchased from the golf club. No alcohol is to be brought onto the golf course from an outside agent. It is illegal under the Liquor and Gaming Regulations and heavy fines apply for the Club and for the offending person. Spot checks may be performed on all eskies, cart containers and buggy sheds, with illegal drinks being confiscated and the offending person facing disciplinary action.

Smoking Policy (Designated outdoor smoking areas - DOSA)

Because the golf course is a licensed area, the smoking legislation will apply. At least 50% of the golf course must be a designated non-smoking area. The designated smoking and non-smoking areas are as follows:

- All Tees and Greens will be non-smoking areas.
- The left-hand side of all fairways will be non-smoking areas.
- The right-hand side of all fairways will be a DOSA.
- An imaginary 2 metre area running down the middle of each fairway will be the buffer zone.
- The drinks cart will only be able to operate in the non-smoking area i.e., the left-hand side of the fairway and around greens and tees

Animals on the Course

Animals are not allowed to be brought onto the golf course to protect wildlife, the grass and out of respect to other players.

Course Care

- Sand Buckets – every player MUST carry a sand bucket to replace and fill their divots
- Rakes – all rakes must be placed within the blue lines in the bunker
- Pitch Marks – all pitch marks on greens must be repaired

Complaints

All complaints shall be made in writing to the General Manager of the Club.

Mobile Phones

- Must be on silent
- May be used for scoring purposes

Social Play

- May be booking through the kiosk, the Pacific Golf app, members portal or the pro shop.
- Timesheets are accessible 8 days prior to the desired day of play.
- Advanced bookings may be booked with approval with the Director of Golf.

Member Guests

Members are encouraged to bring visitors to the Club, for both golf and social occasions. Members are responsible for the behaviour and dress of their guests at all times. Members can bring guests for competition and social everyday, excluding competition on a Saturday.

Reciprocal Members

Must show a current membership card or a letter of introduction from their home Club.
